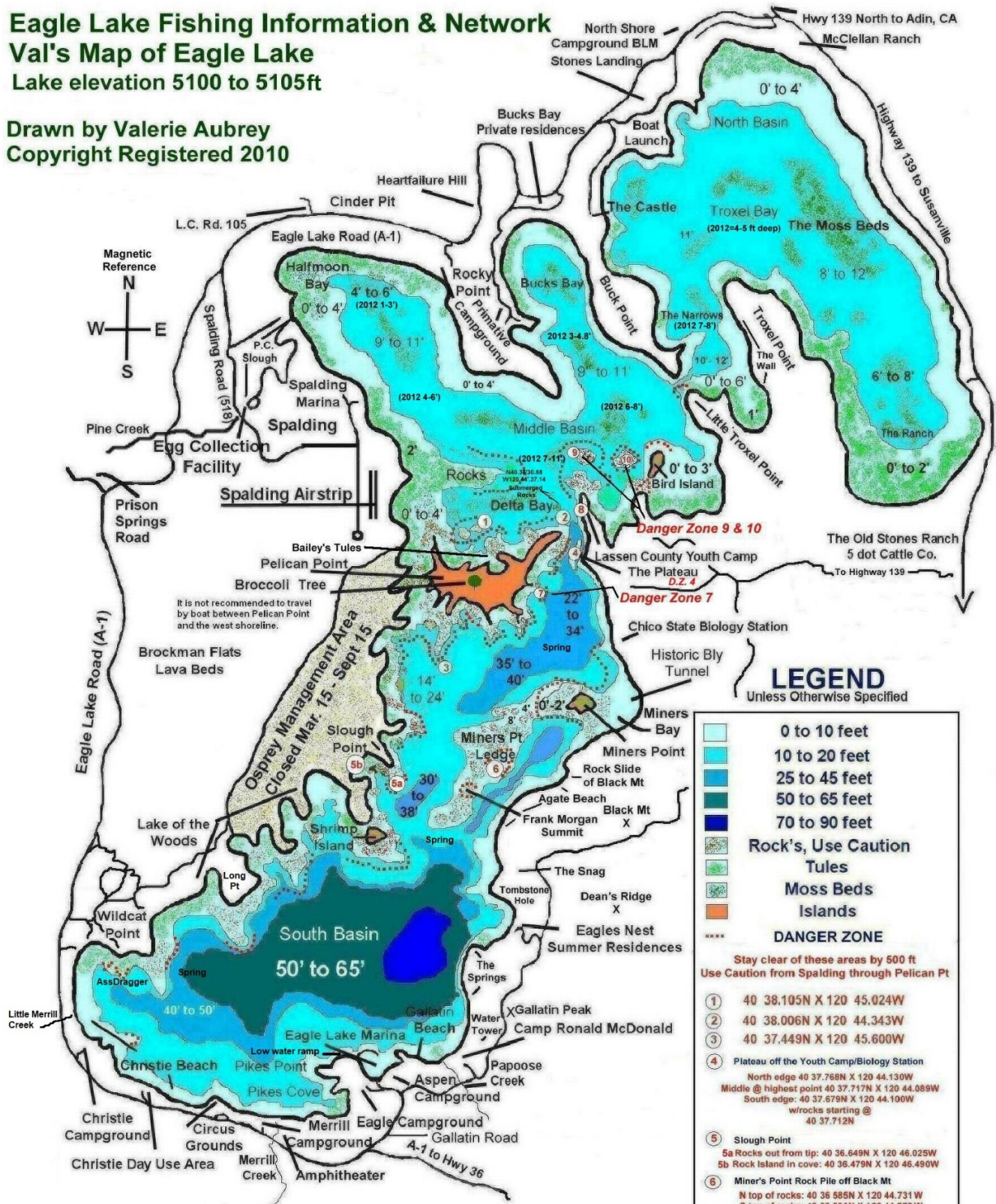


Eagle Lake Fishing Information & Network

 - 7 Southeastern point on Pelican Pt

 - 8 Youth Camp: east buoy marking end of channel
40 38.203N X 120 44.115W
 - 9 Rock Pile extending out north of Youth Camp
40 38.468N X 120 44.041W
 - 10 Rocks between Bird Island & Youth Camp
West edge: 40 38.550N X 120 43.924W
East edge: 40 38.527N X 120 43.690W

This map represents Eagle Lake at its healthy elevation of 5106ft. Recent drought years dropped the lake elevation 15ft. By 2017 we were down 12ft and hope to rebound in the next few years.
